#### Special Pancake Day Thanks

This year when we went to get our Pancake Trailer ready for all of our activities coming up, we found that we had one tire that was approximately 50% low on air and two others that were down about 30%. We tried to add air to them but found the one would not hold. It was decided that since one tire had been patched once already, we needed to just tow the trailer over to Billups on Roosevelt and have them take care of it for us. Later that day, Wyman received a call from Jon Billups. We were informed that the tires on the trailer were really not the correct tire to have installed. Jon went on to say that he would donate four new tires for us and it would be his donation to Kiwanis. This is a nice gift to us, considering we were just trying to get one tire fixed and the others aired up.

Then, the Friday before Pancake Day, we moved the trailer to the north Port parking lot. We had trouble turning and using the jack on the front of the trailer earlier and had thought that we needed to look into that after all the activities were completed. As we went to use the jack to get the trailer off Chip's truck so he could go back to work, it snapped and dropped back onto the ball of the truck. It would no longer work at all. So, we decided to use my car jack and some wood to raise the trailer off the ball. As we ran the car jack up, it would not release from the ball on Chip's truck. Maybe just alittle higher and it will release. One turn of the car jack, a loud pop and the trailer came up quickly off the ball and immediately moved to the side and fell down to the ground. Now we have our trailer down on the ground and no way to get under the 3-4" left to raise it up. Again we turned to Billups downtown location. Two hours later, we got the call that they had not only raised the trailer up for us, they went out and found a new jack and installed it also. When I went to pay the bill, Leif told me if I would pay for the jack they had to buy, they would take care of all the labor involved as a donation.

Now because of the generosity of Billups, our Pancake trailer has four new tires and a new jack. Total cost to the Club, \$58.00. Please remember to give your thanks to Jon Billups and his employees, should you happen to see them.
