The Annual Pancake Breakfast is our biggest fund raiser of the year and member sales are by far the largest contributor to those sales. In 2008 a total of 4,252 tickets were sold of which members were directly responsible for 2,822 tickets sold.

The ticket committee assembles packets for all member and passes them out at Thursday Noon meetings. Ticket packets remaining after three meetings are delivered or mailed to members. Packets contain



10 adult and 5 child tickets for new members and for those members who sold less than 10 tickets last year. Members who sold larger quantities of tickets last year receive larger packets to minimize the number of times they will need to get additional tickets. Members can pick up additional tickets at any meeting or by calling the ticket co-chairmen.

Money from ticket sales may be mailed or turned in at any meeting but for simplicity it is recommended that money be held and turned in at the May 28 meeting following the Pancake Breakfast.


